3. Construction of a 200x400 feet 'Guru Nanak Satsang Bhawan' for the seating of the Sadh Sangat during large gatherings at Sri Bhaini Sahib.

4. In memory of Sri Mata Bhupinder Kaur Ji - Dharamshala at Gurusar (Malwa).

5. Namdhari Dharamshala at Rampura Phul in memory of the martyred Sikhs of Malwa.

6. Reconstruction of Namdhari Martyrdom Monument (Ludhiana).

7. Establishment of a Dharamshala in the village of 'Bangalipur' (Tarn Taran) in memory of Suba Sahib Singh Ji.

8. He constructed the 'Satguru Ram Singh Dharamshala' at MaisarKhana (Malwa).

9. Construction of 'Namdhari Dharamshala' at Bhai Rupa village

10. 35 acres of land in the city of Melbourne, Australia Purchased and built a large hall for various events.

11. 97 acres of land were purchased in the city of Toronto, Canada, so that large gatherings of the Sadh Sangat could be held easily.

2. The series of 1.25 lakh Paths of Sri Adi Guru Granth Sahib Ji, started by Satguru Jagjit Singh Ji, was completed in 2019 AD. Later, a series of 11000 Paths was started, which has been completed and the next series will continue continuously.

3. Online classes for Namdhari children were started for music, Punjabi, Gurmukhi and Gurbani Santhiya.

4. Printing and publication of Sri Dasam Guru Granth Sahib and the Namdhari Nitnem Steek, which includes simple and easy-to-understand meanings of the Nitnem Bani

5. Organizing Havan Yagyas by performing one hundred twenty-five thousand recitations of Chandi Di Vaar and Chaupai.

6. Establishment of Namdhari Football Team at Sri Bhaini Sahib.

7. Inauguration of Namdhari Sports Academy and construction of new grounds at Sri Jiwan Nagar.

8. Organizing annual music concerts in the memory of Satguru Jagjit Singh Ji.

9 The documentary 'Sangeet Saroop Satgur' was created to highlight Sri Satguru Jagjit Singh Ji's deep devotion to classical and Gurmat music.

10. Satguru Jagjit Singh Gurmat Sangeet and Shastri Sangeet Competition in which students from all over the country participate.



11. The 'Birdhshala' (old age home) at Sri Bhaini Sahib was significantly expanded and upgraded with modern facilities to better care for the elderly and the sick.
12. Publication of dozens of old and new books related to Namdhari literature.
13. To stay connected with religious activities in the age of media, the 'Sri Bhaini Sahib Mobile App and YouTube Channel' were introduced.
14. New construction and expansion of cowshed at Sri Bhaini Sahib for the conservation of indigenous cattle breed.
15. Upgrading the Satjug newspaper, established since 1920, into a magazine and launching the 'Satjug app' for online reading.
16. Regular visits were made to countries such as Thailand, England, America, Europe, Africa, Australia, and Canada to spiritually connect the Sangat with Naam, Gurbani, and Sikh principles.
17. A 'Dharam Parcharak Course' was launched to train Namdhari youth to become dedicated Jathedars and effective Parcharaks.
18. Numerous youth camps were organized to help young people in India and abroad learn about and embrace Sikh principles.
